

3 Lies stopping you from progressing:

Lie #1 - You are NOT good enough.

You ARE good enough.

Making a decision out of FEAR of not being good enough is hard to overcome. Social media is curated and the algorithm is confusing. Regardless, DONT let FEAR make a decision for you. Your intuition is telling you to try (more than once!). The hard part is starting. So start.
