EV HALES WORKSHOP 14-15 SEPTEMBER

Ten artists attended, three being from Canberra. Saturday was spent painting flowers using a very loose style wetting paper and dropping in background pigment and once dry looking for spaces in which to create our flowers and foliage. Ev talked about flower patterns and how to incorporate them onto the background we had created making our brush strokes echo the shapes and direction of the flower. Big brush for big petals!

We were encouraged to avoid staining and opaque colours as these cannot be lifted out once applied. We had varying degrees of success and of course with practice this will be an enjoyable style to paint.

Sunday was devoted to seascapes, waves and water. Did we want wave motion flowing over rocks or crashing on to headlands. Did we want still water with reflections and sparkles. Will I use rough or smooth paper to get the effect I want. Again, personal preference and choice of rough or smooth paper. Ev showed us how to 'make waves' and sparkles which when applied brought our pictures to life.

Another great learning curve in watercolour application and techniques by Ev Hales. Key points:

Select your subject and surface on which you want to paint, wet or dry application, colour pallet – choose a limited palette to explore colour possibilities - fewer choices makes the process simpler and a good selection of brushes.

We hope to secure Ev again for next year and if you can get to one of her workshops you will learn a lot and not be disappointed. The secret is to keep painting to achieve the excellence you want.

NSW ART GALLERY EXHIBITION

Last week I attended the Alphonse Mucha: Spirit of Art Noveau exhibition at the NSW Art Gallery. The exhibition was in the new building and it was very well set out with excellent information about the works.

In close cooperation with the Mucha Foundation, Prague, the exhibition is drawn from the Mucha Family Collection. Bringing together Mucha's illustrations, jewellery, interior decoration, photographs and more, the exhibition reveals an artist and designer whose powerful influence remains with us today.

Mucha is probably best known for his posters of the legendary actress, Sarah Bernhadt, but he was an artist who embraced many genres.

Mucha was born in Moravia (now in the Czech Republic) but he studied and worked in Vienna and Paris.

It was interesting to see the many different ways in which he expressed his artistic talent. He even dabbled in photography and I especially like the black and white photo showing the shambolic state of his studio!
